DISCUSSION

53 year old who underwent a prostate needle in light of a PSA value of 5.0 by report.

His past medical history is notable for aortic aneurysm and hip pain.

RADIOLOGY

CT and bone scan: negative for metastasis, status post repair of aortic dissection

Bone scan negative for metastatic disease

PATHOLOGY

Gleason 5+4=9 in 2 cores and 4+5=9 in 1 core (all right sided) (second opinion suggests predominantly 4+4 instead of 5+4) Perineural invasion was not identified. The remaining 9 cores are negative.

RECOMMENDATIONS

High risk prostate cancer in a 53 year old patient

Laparoscopic Radical Prostatectomy

Open Radical Prostatectomy

Bilateral Pelvic Lymph Node

Unilateral Nerve Sparing Procedure

consider vascular consult

Adjuvant Hormonal Therapy
